
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VOTER REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-111, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:
3 "**§286-111 Application for license, provisional license, or**
4 **instruction permit; fees.** (a) Every application for an
5 instruction permit, provisional license, or driver's license
6 shall be made upon a form furnished by the examiner of drivers
7 and shall be verified by the applicant before a person
8 authorized to administer oaths. The examiner of drivers and
9 officers serving under the examiner may administer the oaths
10 without charge. Each application for an instruction permit for
11 a category (1), (2), (3), or (4) license shall be accompanied by
12 a fee to be determined by the council of each county and each
13 application for a provisional license or driver's license shall
14 be accompanied by the fee, unless the applicant has already paid
15 the fee upon application for an instruction permit in the same
16 county, in which event no fee shall be charged. An additional
17 fee to be determined by the council of each county shall be
18 charged and collected upon the issuance of a provisional license



1 or driver's license. All of the foregoing fees shall become
2 county realizations.

3 (b) The director of transportation shall establish a fee
4 schedule for all commercial driver's licensing examinations.
5 The fees collected for a commercial driver's license shall
6 become state realizations and deposited in the state highway
7 fund. The State shall reimburse the counties all costs for
8 administering the commercial driver's licensing program. The
9 amount of reimbursement shall be determined by the director of
10 transportation.

11 (c) Every application shall state the full name, date of
12 birth, sex, occupation, social security number if the applicant
13 is eligible for a social security number, the residence address
14 and business address, if any, of the applicant, and shall
15 briefly describe the applicant, and shall state whether the
16 applicant has theretofore been licensed as a driver, and, if so,
17 when and in what state or country, and whether any such license
18 has ever been suspended or revoked, or whether an application
19 has ever been refused, and if so, the date of and reason for the
20 suspension, revocation, or refusal.

21 (d) If the applicant is not eligible to receive a social
22 security number, the applicant shall submit, in lieu of



1 providing proof of social security number pursuant to subsection
2 (c):

3 (1) A United States Social Security Administration letter
4 stating that the applicant is ineligible to obtain a
5 social security number; and

6 (2) Either:

7 (A) A government-issued photo identification
8 document; or

9 (B) Other identification documents as deemed
10 acceptable by the director.

11 (e) In the case of persons who are at least sixteen years
12 of age but under the age of eighteen, the application for an
13 instruction permit or provisional license shall be made upon a
14 form that requires the information set forth in section 11-15(a)
15 not already required by subsection (c) and that shall serve to
16 automatically register the person to vote upon reaching age
17 eighteen."

18 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
 2 provided that the amendments made by this Act shall not be
 3 repealed when Act 72, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is repealed
 4 on January 9, 2011.
