A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC ACCESS TO BEACHES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the courts of this
- 2 state and the legislature have consistently supported and
- 3 ensured the rights of the public to access the shoreline and
- 4 inland mountain areas of the state for recreational and cultural
- 5 purposes. One factor that has led to denial of public access to
- 6 certain shoreline and inland areas is the proliferation of
- 7 private communities with gates, guard stations, and private
- 8 roadways. Another factor that contributes to the lack of public
- 9 access, especially to beaches, is the lack of parking areas for
- 10 access to the shoreline.

- 11 The legislature believes that a critical step in solving
- 12 this issue is to definitively locate all existing public access
- 13 ways to the shorelines throughout the state.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding to survey and
- 15 map all existing public access ways to shorelines throughout the
- 16 state.
- 17 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general

- 1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to
- 2 survey and map all existing public access ways to shoreline

- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 5 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
