
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A STUDY ON ENERGY EFFICIENT
TRANSPORTATION STRATEGIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds transportation is
2 responsible for an inordinate amount of fuel consumption,
3 including fuel used in motor vehicles, busses, and jet planes.
4 The legislature further finds that reducing the demand for fuel
5 in transportation modalities would greatly reduce our dependence
6 on oil.

7 The Hawaii energy policy forum, a part of the social
8 sciences public policy center at the University of Hawaii at
9 Manoa, proposes to conduct a study on energy efficient
10 transportation strategies in conjunction with the department of
11 business, economic development, and tourism.

12 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for an
13 energy efficiency transportation strategies study.

14 SECTION 2. (a) The Hawaii energy policy forum at the
15 University of Hawaii at Manoa shall conduct a study on energy
16 efficient transportation strategies in conjunction with the
17 department of business, economic development, and tourism.



1 (b) The energy efficiency transportation strategies study
2 under subsection (a) shall include, but not be limited to:

3 (1) Developing tangible goals, objectives, desired
4 outcomes, and actions to implement an energy efficient
5 transportation strategy;

6 (2) Developing implementation benchmarks for measuring
7 outcomes of energy efficient transportation
8 strategies; and

9 (3) A cost-benefit analysis of each energy efficient
10 transportation strategy.

11 (c) The social sciences public policy center shall engage
12 and integrate Hawaii's business, government, labor, and
13 community leaders into the study on energy efficient
14 transportation strategies.

15 (d) The department of business, economic development, and
16 tourism shall consult with and otherwise assist the social
17 sciences public policy center at the University of Hawaii at
18 Manoa on the energy efficient transportation strategies study.

19 (e) The Hawaii energy policy forum shall submit a report
20 on its findings and recommendations to the legislature not later
21 than twenty days prior to the concurring of the 2008 regular
22 session.



1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000 or thereof as
3 may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for a study on energy
4 efficient transportation strategies.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
6 Hawaii, social sciences public policy center, for the purpose of
7 this Act.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
