

1 § **-2 Board; appointment.** There is established the
2 board of plumbers consisting of five members. Two of the
3 members shall be engaged in the plumbing trade. Three of the
4 members shall be private citizens not connected with the
5 industry.

6 § **-3 Powers and duties of board.** In addition to any
7 other powers and duties authorized by law, the board shall have
8 all the powers and duties necessary or convenient to carry out
9 and effectuate this chapter, including but not limited to the
10 following powers and duties:

- 11 (1) To grant licenses which shall be renewable for:
- 12 (A) Master plumbers; and
- 13 (B) Journey worker plumbers;
- 14 (2) To adopt, amend, or repeal rules in accordance with
15 chapter 91 as it may deem proper to effectuate this
16 chapter and to insure the safety and welfare of the
17 general public; provided that the rules may forbid
18 acts or practices deemed by the board to be
19 detrimental to the accomplishment of the purpose of
20 this chapter;



1 (3) To enforce this chapter and rules adopted pursuant to
2 this chapter and chapter 91, including the denial,
3 suspension, or revocation of any license; and

4 (4) To examine all applicants and licensees to determine
5 their qualifications prior to the issuance or renewal
6 of licenses.

7 § -4 **Minimum requirements.** An applicant shall possess
8 the following minimum qualifications:

9 (1) Journey worker plumber. Every applicant to be
10 eligible for the journey worker plumber examination
11 shall furnish satisfactory evidence of experience of
12 at least five years' full-time or its equivalent but
13 not less than ten thousand hours as a journey worker's
14 or master plumber's helper.

15 (2) Master plumber. Every applicant to be eligible for
16 the master plumber examination shall have been
17 registered with the board as a journey worker plumber
18 for at least two years or shall furnish satisfactory
19 evidence of equivalent experience in the trade.

20 § -5 **Examination.** (a) Every applicant shall be
21 examined and shall pass an examination to be eligible for
22 licensure. The board shall provide in its rules the passing



1 score for the examination. The board may examine applicants or
2 may contract with professional testing services to prepare,
3 administer, and grade the examination as may be required for the
4 purposes of this section.

5 (b) Every applicant shall pay an examination fee as
6 provided in rules adopted by the director pursuant to chapter
7 91. Should the board contract with a professional testing
8 agency to prepare, administer, and grade the examination, the
9 examination fee may be paid directly to the testing agency by
10 the director or the examinee.

11 § -6 Fees; renewals. (a) Renewal fees shall be paid
12 to the board before July 1.

13 (b) Plumbers shall renew the license every three years
14 effective June 30, 2006 and shall pay all required fees. Prior
15 to the June 30, 2009 renewal of the license, and prior to every
16 license renewal thereafter, the applicant shall:

17 (1) Pay all required fees; and

18 (2) Meet the requirements prescribed in section 448E-8.5.

19 (c) Failure, neglect, or refusal of any licensee to pay

20 the renewal fee or meet the requirements of section 448E-8.5

21 before the renewal date shall constitute a forfeiture of the

22 license. Any license so forfeited may be restored upon written



1 application within one year from the date of forfeiture, upon
2 payment of the required renewal fee plus penalty fees and upon
3 meeting the requirements in section -7.

4 § -7 **Continued competency; license renewals.** (a)

5 Prior to each license renewal, all licensed plumbers shall:

6 (1) Furnish the board with proof of attendance at an
7 educational course related to current updates of the
8 Uniform Plumbing Code conducted or approved by the
9 community colleges; or

10 (2) Successfully complete an examination prescribed by the
11 board on current updates to the Uniform Plumbing Code.
12 The board shall contract with a professional testing
13 agency to prepare, administer, and grade the
14 examination. A licensee shall pay all fees related to
15 the examination directly to the professional testing
16 agency.

17 (b) A licensee who has been issued a new license within
18 one year of the renewal date shall not be required to take the
19 course or the examination to renew the licensee's license.

20 § -8 **Unlicensed activity.** (a) No person shall act or
21 assume to act as a journey worker plumber or master plumber, or
22 advertise or hold the person's self out as a plumber without a



1 license previously obtained in compliance with this chapter and
2 the rules of the board; provided that any person may perform
3 emergency plumbing repair work in the person's principal place
4 of residence when such repairs do not involve or require
5 rearrangement of valves, pipes, or fixtures; provided further
6 that no such emergency repairs may be performed on sewer lines,
7 drains, gas lines, and on fixtures being served with backflow
8 devices which include heaters, water closets, dishwashers, and
9 garbage disposal units.

10 For purposes of this subsection, "plumber" means any person
11 who performs plumbing work and includes but is not limited to
12 any person who acts as a journey worker plumber or master
13 plumber.

14 (b) An apprentice or trainee learning the trade of a
15 person licensed as a plumber under this chapter shall not be
16 required to have a license if the apprentice or trainee acts
17 under the supervision of a person appropriately licensed under
18 this chapter.

19 (c) Upon entry of a judgment by a court of competent
20 jurisdiction finding that the person has advertised in violation
21 of this section, the entity furnishing voice communication



1 service to the violator shall disconnect the telephone number
2 contained in the advertisement or listing.

3 § -9 **Suspension; revocation; fine; denial of issuance**
4 **or renewal of a license.** (a) In addition to any other actions
5 authorized by law the board, after notice and hearing as
6 provided in chapter 91, may suspend or revoke any license, or
7 impose fines, or prior to the notice and hearing, deny the
8 issuance or renewal of any license for any cause authorized by
9 law, including but not limited to the following:

- 10 (1) Obtaining, or attempting to obtain a license by fraud,
11 misrepresentation, or deceit;
- 12 (2) Gross negligence, incompetency, misconduct, or
13 dishonesty in the practice of the profession;
- 14 (3) False, fraudulent, or deceptive advertising;
- 15 (4) Permitting an unlicensed person to perform activities
16 requiring a license;
- 17 (5) Aiding or abetting an unlicensed person to violate
18 this chapter;
- 19 (6) Allowing a person's license to be used by an
20 unlicensed person;



1 (7) Acting as an agent, partner, or associate of an
2 unlicensed person engaging in an activity in violation
3 of this chapter; or

4 (8) Violating any provision of this chapter or rule of the
5 board.

6 (b) Any person who violates any provision of this chapter
7 shall be fined not less than \$100 and not more than \$5,000 for
8 each violation.

9 § -10 **Injunction.** The board may, in addition to any
10 other remedy available, apply to a circuit court judge for a
11 temporary restraining order or preliminary or permanent
12 injunction restraining any person from acting, or assuming to
13 act as a journey worker plumber or master plumber without a
14 license previously obtained in compliance with this chapter and
15 the rules of the board, and upon hearing and for cause shown,
16 the judge may grant the temporary restraining order or
17 preliminary or permanent injunction.

18 § -11 **Inspections.** Nothing in this chapter should
19 deprive the several counties of the right to perform plumbing
20 inspections as regulated by their respective ordinances."

21 SECTION 2. Section 26-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
22 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:



1 "(c) The board of acupuncture, board of public
2 accountancy, board of barbering and cosmetology, boxing

8 examiners, motor vehicle industry licensing board, motor vehicle

10 of nursing, board of examiners in optometry, pest control board,
11 board of pharmacy, board of physical therapy, board of
12 psychology, board of private detectives and guards, real estate
13 commission, board of veterinary examiners, board of speech
14 pathology and audiology, and any board, commission, program, or
15 entity created pursuant to or specified by statute in
16 furtherance of the purpose of this section, including but not
17 limited to section 26H-4, or chapters 484, 514B, and 514E shall
18 be placed within the department of commerce and consumer affairs
19 for administrative purposes."

5 (2) Journey worker specialty electrician. Every applicant
6 to be eligible for the journey worker specialty
7 electrician examination shall be at least eighteen
8 years of age and shall have had at least five years'
9 experience in the trade.

10 (3) Supervising electrician. Every applicant to be
11 eligible for the supervising electrician examination
12 shall have been registered with the board as a journey
13 worker electrician for at least a period of four years
14 in the trade or shall have had equivalent experience
15 in the trade.

16 (4) Supervising specialty electrician. Every applicant to
17 be eligible for the supervising specialty electrician
18 examination shall have been registered with the board
19 as a journey worker specialty electrician for at least
20 a period of four years in the trade or shall have had
21 equivalent experience in the trade.
