1 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
3 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. The director of finance is authorized to issue
5 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$700,000 or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2007-2008 to
8 replace the Pohoiki boat ramp and loading dock on the island of
9 Hawaii.

10 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital
11 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
12 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
13 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
14 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

15 SECTION 5. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
16 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of
17 this Act.

18 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
