## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STANDARDS OF CONDUCT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. 1 Section 84-11.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Every legislator and employee shall file a gifts disclosure statement with the state ethics commission on June 30 4 of each year if all the following conditions are met: 5 6 The legislator or employee, or spouse or dependent (1)child of a legislator or employee, received directly 7 or indirectly from one source any gift or gifts valued 8 singly or in the aggregate in excess of  $[\$200_{-}]$  \$100, 9 10 whether the gift is in the form of money, service, goods, or in any other form; 11 (2) The source of the gift or gifts have interests that 12 may be affected by official action or lack of action 13 14 by the legislator or employee; and The gift is not exempted by subsection (d) from 15 (3) 16 reporting requirements under this [subsection.] 17 section."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act shall apply to gift disclosures filed
- 2 for the period beginning on June 1, 2007.
- 3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
