
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE INTERMEDIATE COURT OF APPEALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 602-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§602-51 How constituted.** The intermediate appellate
4 court shall consist of a chief judge and [~~five~~] seven associate
5 judges. The chief judge, who shall be specifically selected,
6 shall supervise the administrative duties of the court."

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$660,314, or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the
10 sum of \$611,678, or so much thereof as may be necessary for
11 fiscal year 2008-2009, for costs related to and for the
12 establishment of:

- 13 (1) Two intermediate court of appeals judges;
14 (2) Four intermediate court of appeals law clerks; and
15 (3) Two intermediate court of appeals judicial assistants.

16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
17 for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
