## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROSTITUTION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 712-1207, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (4) to read as follows:

3           "(4) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any person  
4 violating this section shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor  
5 and shall be sentenced to a mandatory term of thirty days  
6 imprisonment. The term of imprisonment shall be imposed  
7 immediately, regardless of whether the defendant appeals the  
8 conviction, except as provided in subsection (5). In addition,  
9 the court may require that the photograph of any person  
10 convicted under this section be published in a newspaper of  
11 general circulation in the county in which the person was  
12 convicted, at the expense of the person convicted."

13           SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
15 begun, before its effective date.

16           SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
