HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY AND THE HAWAII HOUSING FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO CREATE A REDEVELOPMENT MASTER PLAN FOR KUKUI GARDENS AND MAYOR WRIGHT HOMES.

1 WHEREAS, Kukui Gardens and Mayor Wright Homes are large affordable housing complexes located in Palama in the City and 2 County of Honolulu; and 3 4 WHEREAS, Kukui Gardens is a low-rise complex comprised of 5 6 eight hundred fifty-seven affordable units, and it houses approximately twenty-five hundred residents; and 7 8 WHEREAS, Mayor Wright Homes is a low-rise complex comprised 9 of three hundred sixty-three units that have continuously 10 11 suffered from maintenance problems; and 12 WHEREAS, Hawaii is in need of more affordable housing units 13 for low- and moderate-income households; and 14 15 WHEREAS, homelessness and a shortage of affordable housing 16 continue to be two of the State's most significant and 17 challenging social problems; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Public Housing Authority indicates that 20 the waiting list for public housing is approximately seven 21 thousand people; and 22 23 WHEREAS, Kukui Gardens and Mayor Wright Homes are located 24 in an area zoned by the City and County of Honolulu as an A-2 25 medium-density apartment district with regulated building 26 heights of one hundred fifty feet; and 27 28 29 WHEREAS, there is a planned transit stop at the nearby junction of Dillingham Boulevard and Liliha Street; and 30 31

WHEREAS, lower income families are the most likely to use 1 2 public mass transit; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the Kukui Gardens and Mayor Wright Homes properties are not being utilized to their highest and best use; 5 6 and 7 WHEREAS, the State owns half of Kukui Gardens, all of Mayor 8 Wright Homes, and a strip of land located on Liliha Street 9 10 between the two complexes; now, therefore, 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 13 Session of 2008, the Senate concurring, that the Hawaii Public 14 15 Housing Authority and the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation are requested to create a master plan to redevelop 16 Kukui Gardens and Mayor Wright Homes while also utilizing the 17 state-owned strip of land located on Liliha Street to include 18 19 mixed use commercial and residential market rate housing as well 20 as low- to moderate-income housing; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Public Housing 23 Authority on behalf of itself and the Hawaii Housing Finance and 24 Development Corporation is requested to submit a report of their findings and recommendations to the Legislature no later than 25 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 26 27 2009; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Executive Director 30 of the Hawaii Public Housing Authority and the Executive 31 Director of the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development 32 33 Corporation. 34 Hal Nooh 35 36 OFFERED BY:
