## HOUSE RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING THE SECOND WEEK OF JUNE AS MEN'S HEALTH WEEK.

WHEREAS, despite rapid advances in medical technology and 1 research, men still have a shorter average life span than women; 2 3 and 4 5 WHEREAS, diseases that solely afflict men such as 6 testicular cancer and prostate cancer represent some of the biggest health risks for men; and 7 8 WHEREAS, men die of cancer at 1.5 times the rate for women; 9 10 and 11 WHEREAS, all ten of the leading causes of death impact men 12 at a higher percentage than women; and 13 14 WHEREAS, one of the biggest obstacles to improving the 15 16 health of men is a lack of awareness and apathy that many men have towards obtaining medical treatment; and 17 18 WHEREAS, educating the public and health care providers 19 about the importance of a healthy lifestyle and early detection 20 of male health problems may eventually lead to reduced mortality 21 rates from diseases such as cancer and heart disease; and 22 23 WHEREAS, men who are educated about the value of preventive 24 health will be more likely to participate in health screening 25 programs; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the Men's Health Network worked with the United 28 States Congress to develop National Men's Health Week as a 29 special campaign to help educate men and their families about 30 the importance of positive health attitudes and preventive 31 health practices; and 32



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WHEREAS, Hawaii Men's Health Week will focus on a broad 1 2 range of men's health issues, including heart disease, diabetes, prostate, testicular, and colon cancer; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, citizens of this State are encouraged to increase 6 their awareness of the importance of a healthy lifestyle, regular exercise, and medical check-ups; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, the Governor issued a proclamation on March 2, 2004, declaring June 14 through 20, 2004, to be Men's Health 10 Week; now, therefore, 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 13 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 14 Session of 2008, that this body officially recognizes the second 15 week of June as Men's Health Week; and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body supports and 18 encourages all national, state, and local efforts to educate the 19 public on men's health issues, and improve access to health care 20 for men of all ages. 21 22 23 24 John M 25 OFFERED BY:
