HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ENCOURAGE EACH ADULT RESIDENTIAL CARE HOME LICENSE APPLICANT TO OFFER TO MAKE A PRESENTATION TO THE RELEVANT NEIGHBORHOOD BOARD IN WHOSE DISTRICT THE HOME IS LOCATED.

WHEREAS, adult residential care homes provide community-1 based care for a fee to persons who cannot live independently, 2 such as those who are aged, disabled, or mentally ill; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the Department of Health licenses two types of adult residential care homes in Hawaii - type I, which may have 6 five or fewer residents unrelated to the home operator, and type 7 II, which may have six or more of such residents; and 8 9 WHEREAS, under section 46-4(d), Hawaii Revised Statutes, a 10 county cannot enact an ordinance that prohibits group living in 11 an adult residential care home by eight or fewer residents 12 13 unrelated to the home operator; and 14 WHEREAS, section 46-4(d), Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 generally taken to mean that a county may not enact a zoning 16 ordinance that makes an adult residential care home an 17 18 impermissible use in a district zoned residential or that imposes a separation between adult residential care homes of a 19 specified minimum distance; and 20 21 WHEREAS, adult residential care homes provide an important 22 23 public service, the need for which will only increase in the future as the population of Hawaii ages; and 24 25 WHEREAS, adult residential care homes are necessary as a 26 more appropriate and less expensive alternative setting for 27 28 persons who cannot live independently but do not exhibit infirmities severe enough to require institutional nursing care; 29 30 and 31 WHEREAS, despite the public need for and benefit of adult 32 residential care homes, some communities become concerned when 33 HR LRB 08-2447.doc

homes are perceived to be excessively concentrated in their 1 2 neighborhoods; and 3 WHEREAS, these community concerns and fears can be 4 5 addressed and mitigated by the presentation to the public of accurate information on the proposed locations and planned 6 operations of adult care homes before their licensure; and 7 8 WHEREAS, on Oahu, the neighborhood board system is 9 10 available for the making of such presentations; now, therefore, 11 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 12 13 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, that the Department of Health is requested to 14 encourage each adult care home license applicant to offer to 15 make an informational and educational presentation to the 16 relevant neighborhood board in whose district the applicant's 17 18 proposed home and planned operation is to be located; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is 21 requested to encourage each adult care home license applicant to submit the offer to the relevant neighborhood board as early as 22 23 possible before a decision on licensure; and 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is 25 26 requested to submit to the Legislature at least twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2009 a report 27 on the Department's action taken; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 30 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health and the 31 Executive Secretary of the Honolulu Neighborhood Commission, who 32 in turn is requested to distribute copies to all neighborhood 33 34 board chairs. 35 36 37 OFFERED BY: a B.
