HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE MAUI COUNTY CIVIL DEFENSE AGENCY TO PREPARE A DISASTER CONTINGENCY PLAN TO MAINTAIN CONTINUED TRANSPORTATION ACCESS ALONG THE HANA HIGHWAY, INCLUDING ITS ONE-LANE BRIDGES, DURING CATASTROPHIC EVENTS.

1 WHEREAS, it is critical for the safety, health, and well-2 being of residents of rural areas in the State, particularly 3 those areas where access is restricted to single-lane roads 4 served by numerous bridges, that transportation be maintained in 5 anticipation of catastrophic events such as earthquakes and 6 flooding; and

8 WHEREAS, Hawaii experienced two large seismic events on
9 October 15, 2006, that caused electrical blackouts and
10 disruption to transportation in various areas of the State; and
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12 WHEREAS, on the island of Maui, especially on the road 13 between Hana and Kipahulu on the southeastern side of the 14 island, several bridges on the one-lane road were damaged when 15 the earthquakes fractured rock foundations beneath the bridges; 16 and

18 WHEREAS, Paihi Bridge on the Hana Highway had to be closed 19 and replaced with a temporary bridge, and military helicopters 20 had to make deliveries of food, water, and fuel to residents 21 affected by the shutdown of the bridge; and

23 WHEREAS, during the summer of 2007, a landslide and heavy 24 rains caused flooding that closed the temporary bridge for two 25 months; and

WHEREAS, according to a 2006 United States Department of Transportation assessment, forty-six per cent of Hawaii's bridges (513 of 1,110) are classified substandard, of which 156 are classified structurally deficient and 357 are classified functionally obsolete, ranking Hawaii as the third worst in the nation; and



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WHEREAS, a substandard classification does not necessarily 1 mean that bridges are unsafe, and certain bridges will never be 2 brought up to current federal standards; for example, there is 3 4 no practicable way to provide two-lane access to the more than fifty bridges along the one-lane Hana Highway; and 5 6 7 WHEREAS, as experiences with the earthquakes of 2006 and the landslide and heavy rains during 2007 have nevertheless 8 shown, the Maui County Civil Defense Agency needs to take 9 precautionary measures to maintain continued access to the 10 numerous communities served by the Hana Highway and its many 11 one-lane bridges in the event of a catastrophic event; now, 12 therefore, 13 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 15 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 16 Session of 2008, that the Maui County Civil Defense Agency is 17 18 requested to prepare a disaster contingency plan to maintain 19 continued transportation access along the Hana Highway, including the one-lane bridges along the highway, in the event 20 of catastrophic events such as earthquakes, landslides, or heavy 21 rain and flooding; and 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Maui County Civil Defense 24 Agency is requested to include in the contingency plan the 25 26 following: 27 Identification of potential catastrophic events that 28 (1)may impair transportation access along Hana Highway; 29 30 (2)Feasible plans and actions that can be implemented in 31 preparation and anticipation of each type of 32 catastrophic event, such as seismic retrofitting work 33 to strengthen the one-lane bridges and procurement of 34 Federal Emergency Management Agency funds, plans for 35 alternate routes, and plans for state-county liaison 36 and interagency cooperation; 37 38 39 (3) Actions to be taken during a catastrophic event; and 40 Follow-up actions to be taken after a catastrophic (4) 41 42 event; and 43



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and the Council of Maui County are requested to cooperate with the administrator of the Maui County Civil Defense Agency on the preparation of the disaster contingency plan; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Maui County Civil Defense 7 Agency is requested to submit a report of its findings and 8 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 9 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 10 the Regular Session of 2009; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor and members of the Council of Maui County and to the Civil Defense Administrator for Maui County.
