## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE STATE AND COUNTIES TO COMPILE AN INVENTORY OF ABANDONED, EXCESS, AND UNDERUTILIZED PROPERTIES UNDER THEIR RESPECTIVE JURISDICTION.

1 WHEREAS, the state and county governments are landowners or 2 lessees of real properties and buildings that are intended to 3 serve the public purpose; and 4 WHEREAS, if these properties and buildings are abandoned, 5 unused, underutilized, or otherwise in excess of their 6 7 respective need, the public purpose is not served; and 8 9 WHEREAS, these properties hold the potential for public 10 purpose use to provide government and community services, including housing, early learning centers, and senior services: 11 12 and 13 WHEREAS, private providers of human services need a 14 location for offices and operations; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the lack of affordable land and buildings are 17 critical impediments to providing human services; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, as a preliminary step to utilizing these properties for a public purpose, these properties need to be 21 identified, including the owner, current status of the property, 22 23 zoning, and other pertinent information that indicate the suitability for a public use by government or private agencies 24 25 providing human services; now, therefore, 26 27 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 28 Session of 2008, that the Department of Land and Natural 29 Resources and the planning department of the respective counties 30 31 are requested to compile a report that lists every property 32 under their respective jurisdiction that are: (1) Land or buildings, or both; 33 34

otherwise in excess of their respective needs; and 2 3 (3) Hold the potential for use to provide human services, 4 including but not limited to, housing, early learning 5 centers, and senior services; and 6 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for each such property, the 8 9 report include information on the location, tax map key, zoning, land classification, ownership, current status of use, a 10 description and pictures of the building, and whether the 11 property or building, or both, would be suitable for use to 12 provide human services; and 13 14 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and Natural Resources, Honolulu Department of Planning and 16 17 Permitting, Hawaii County Planning Department, Kauai County Department of Planning, and Maui Department of Planning submit 18 19 their respective report to the Legislature (attention to the 20 Senate Committee on Human Services and Public Housing, and the House Committee on Human Services and Housing) not later than 21 22 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 23 2009; and 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 25 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 26 Land and Natural Resources; Director of Human Services; Director 27 of the Honolulu Department of Planning and Permitting; Director 28 of the Hawaii County Planning Department; Director of the Kauai 29 30 County Department of Planning; and the Director of the Maui 31 Department of Planning. 32 33 34 OFFERED BY:
