## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO CONDUCT A COMPREHENSIVE STUDY AND COST REVIEW OF CERTAIN CARE HOME SERVICES IN HAWAII.

WHEREAS, adult foster homes (AFHs), adult residential care homes (ARCHs), expanded adult residential care homes (E-ARCHs), and community care foster family homes (CCFFHs), either nonprofit or for profit, serve Hawaii's residents; and

WHEREAS, these care homes are designed to provide safe, humane, comfortable, and supportive residential settings for adults who do not need to live in a long-term care facility or require its services, but who require assistance or supervision with activities of daily living; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health licenses ARCHs under section 321-15.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) and E-ARCHs under section 321-15.62, HRS, and certifies AFHs under section 321-11.2, HRS, and the Department of Human Services certifies CCFFH's under section 346-334, HRS; and

WHEREAS, licensing and certification rules strengthen health and safety protections for adult residential care home residents based on current information and research and incorporate state-of-the-art program concepts; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive review of the operational costs incurred by AFHs with disabled adult residents, and ARCHs, E-ARCHs, and CCFFHs, in Hawaii has not been conducted; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive review would be beneficial for operational and administrative purposes; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, that the Governor is requested to conduct a comprehensive study and cost review of services provided by AFHs with disabled adult residents, and ARCHs, E-ARCHs, and CCFFHs,

in Hawaii, including the actual costs incurred to operate these 1 homes; and 2 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to 5 include in the written report at least the following: 6 A comparison of the cost of operating: 7 8 (A)AFHs (section 346-334, HRS) with disabled adult 9 10 residents: 11 A type I ARCH (section 321-15.6(b)(2)(A), HRS); (B) 12 13 (C) A type II ARCH (section 321-15.6(b)(2)(B), HRS); 14 15 An E-ARCH (section 321-15.62, HRS); (D) 16 17 CCFFHs (section 321-11.2, HRS); and 18 (E) 19 (2) A comparison of the costs for ARCHs that serve 20 residents who receive Supplemental Security Income and 21 those homes that do not; 22 23 A determination of costs identified to be one-time (3) 24 costs and those costs identified as recurrent, 25 including staff and administrator training costs; and 26 27 (4)An estimate of the annual cost savings to the State 28 arising from the placement of individuals within 29 ARCHs, E-ARCHs, CCFFHs, and AFHs with disabled adult 30 31 residents, as opposed to placement in long-term care facilities; 32 33 34 and 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to 36 assign any personnel from any executive department or agency to 37 conduct the comprehensive study that the Governor determines to 38

be appropriate; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to 2 submit findings and recommendations, including any necessary proposed legislation, in a report to the Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2009; and
