5 §37-Appropriations available for salaries. No part

of any appropriation shall be available for the payment of the 6

salary of any officer or employee of the State who:

(1) Prohibits or prevents, or attempts or threatens to prohibit or prevent, any officer or employee of the State from having any direct oral or written communication or contact with any member of the legislature or a state legislative committee in connection with any matter pertaining to the employment of the other officer or employee or pertaining to the department or agency of the other officer or employee in any way, regardless of whether the communication or contact is at the initiative of
