RELATING TO LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:


- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the statutes
- 2 providing state and county immunity on certain public lands have
- 3 proven to be beneficial to the state and county governments as
- 4 well as the general public. The liability protections have
- 5 reduced the exposure of the state and county governments to
- 6 substantial damages and, as a result, allowed the state and
- 7 county governments to keep recreational areas with potentially
- 8 dangerous conditions open to the public. Furthermore, the
- 9 warning signage required by the statutes has promoted public
- 10 safety by informing users of the recreational areas of
- 11 potentially dangerous conditions.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to repeal the sunset dates of
- 13 three statutes that provide the state and county governments
- 14 with liability protection for public use of certain state or
- 15 county recreational areas.

- 11 SECTION 4. Act 82, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003, is amended
- 12 by amending section 8 to read as follows:
- "SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2003[7
- 14 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2008]."

- 16 and stricken.
