## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 329B-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by	y amending the definition of "substance abuse on-site	
3	screening	test" to read as follows:	
4	""Substance abuse on-site screening test" means a portable		
5	substance	abuse test that [meets]:	
6	(1)	Meets the requirements of the United States Food and	
7		Drug Administration for commercial distribution; or	
8	(2)	Is manufactured in a facility licensed by the United	
9		States Food and Drug Administration, and may be used	
10		for forensic testing as a workplace testing device;	
11	and is approved by the director [for such pre-employment		
12	screening	]."	
13	SECT	ION 2. Section 329B-5.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
14	amended to read as follows:		
15	"[ <b>+</b> ]:	§329B-5.5[+] Substance abuse on-site screening tests,	
16	testing p	rocedures, and confidentiality. The substance abuse	
17	on-site so	creening test shall be administered for pre-employment	



1	purposes	only according to the instructions of the manufacturer
2	and this	section:
3	(1)	Every employer using a substance abuse on-site
4		screening test for pre-employment screening shall
5		administer the test according to the United States
6		Food and Drug Administration package insert that
7		accompanies the substance abuse test[7]; provided that
8		if there is no United States Food and Drug
9		Administration package insert, then the test shall be
10		administered according to the package insert that
11		accompanies the substance abuse test that is
12		manufactured in a facility licensed by the United
13		States Food and Drug Administration; provided further
14		that manufacturers may apply to the department for
15		interim approval while pursuing Food and Drug
16		Administration approval and shall adhere to any
17		applicable on-site screening drug test guidelines
18		adopted by the United States Food and Drug
19		Administration. Any on-site screening test shall also
20		be approved by the director [for such pre-employment
21		screening];

(2)	Every employer using a substance abuse on-site
	screening test for pre-employment screening shall
	adhere to the rules adopted pursuant to section 329B-8
	pertaining to specimen collection, urine specimen,
	shipping of specimens, chain of custody, and
	confidentiality that may be applicable to on-site drug
	testing; provided that employers are authorized to
	drug test applicants and unions are authorized to drug
	test members;

If a substance abuse on-site screening test obtains a test result that indicates the presence of drugs, alcohol, or the metabolites of drugs; and if the test result may be used to deny or deprive a person of employment or any benefit, or may otherwise result in an adverse action being taken against the person, then the same sample that produced the test result shall be submitted for a confirmatory test to a testing laboratory licensed or approved by the department in accordance with this chapter. A positive confirmatory test shall be reviewed by a medical review officer licensed by the department in accordance with this chapter; and

1	(4) The operator who administers the substance abuse on-
2	site screening test shall have been trained in the use
3	and administering of the on-site screening test by the
4	manufacturer of the on-site screening test or the
5	manufacturer's designee."
6	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050,
9	and shall be repealed on January 1, 2012.

## REPORT Title:

Substance Abuse Testing

## Description:

Amends definition of "substance abuse on-site screening test" to include tests used for forensic testing as a workplace testing device. Requires that substance abuse testing be conducted according to the manufacturer's package insert, as an alternative to the Food and Drug Administration insert if there is no FDA insert. (SB1636 HD1)
