A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that during the 2006
2	legislative session, legislation was passed directing the Hawaii
3	employees' retirement system to conduct an actuarial study to
4	analyze possible improvements to account for the effects of
5	inflation. The actuarial study indicated that the fairest and
,	

- 6 most equitable option, among those suggested, was one that
- 7 addressed the concerns of retirees by:
- 8 (1) Factoring in how many years the retiree has been in retirement; and
- 10 (2) Recognizing how many years of service the retiree has11 rendered to the State.
- The legislature finds that the last ad hoc increase
 provided by the employees' retirement system was during the
 2002-2003 fiscal year. That increase was a one-time, lump sum
 pension bonus for retirees age 70 and older, with 20 or more
- 17 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to help offset the
 18 effects of inflation on older retirees' pensions by providing a

years of service.

1	similar one-time, lump sum payment available only to retirees
2	who are at least 75 years of age and who have been in retirement
3	for at least 20 years. The payment provided by this Act to
4	certain older retirees is a one time, lump sum payment and is
5	not intended to provide an enhanced pension benefit.
6	SECTION 2. Section 88-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	"§88-11 Bonus; pensioners' special compensation; amounts
9	available. Except as herein provided, every pension payable
10	under the employees' retirement system or payable pursuant to
11	any law of the State, or by any county or independent public
12	board or commission, shall be increased by a bonus for each
13	month as follows:
14	(1) Effective July 1, 1976, \$77.82 per month to those
15	retirants and pensioners who had, before July 1, 1966,
16	ten or more years of service; provided that any member
17	who is retired because of physical or mental
18	disability due to any injury or disease incurred while
19	in the performance of the member's duty as a public
20	employee shall be entitled to receive the bonus
21	payment without meeting the minimum service

- (3) Effective July 1, 1976, \$31.12 per month additional to the above bonus or bonuses to those retirants or pensioners who have had twenty-one or more years of service;

10		notwithstanding, there shall be paid to every person
11		who on June 30, 1965, was receiving a retirement
12		allowance from the system or other pension payable
13		under or pursuant to the law of the State or by any
14		county or independent board or commission, a special
15		cost of living bonus, which shall be paid in the
16		following manner:
17		(A) On January 1, 1966, seven and one-half per cent
18		of the retirement allowance or pension;
19		(B) On July 1, 1969, an additional ten per cent of
20		the retirement allowance or pension;
21		(C) On July 1, 1970, an additional ten per cent of

the retirement allowance or pension;

1		(D) On July 1, 1973, an additional five and one-half
2		per cent of the retirement allowance or pension;
3		and
4		(E) On July 1, 1976, an additional eight per cent of
5		the retirement allowance or pension;
6	(7)	Any provision of this section to the contrary
7		notwithstanding, there shall be paid to every person
8		who retired between July 1, 1965, and June 30, 1970,
9		and who, on June 30, 1974, was receiving a retirement
10		allowance from the system or other pension payable
11		under or pursuant to the law of the State or by any
12		county or independent board or commission, a special
13		cost of living bonus which shall be paid in the
14		following manner:
15		(A) On July 1, 1974, five and one-half per cent of
16		the retirement allowance or pension; and
17		(B) On July 1, 1976, an additional eight per cent of
18		the retirement allowance or pension;
19	(8)	Any other provision to the contrary notwithstanding,
20		effective July 1, 1980, there shall be paid to every
21		person who retired prior to July 1, 1975, and who on

June 30, 1980, was receiving a retirement allowance

1	from the system or other pension payable under or				
2	pursuant to the law of the State or by any county or				
3	independent board or commission, a special cost of				
4	living bonus, which shall be paid in the following				
5	manner:				
6	(A) \$4.50 a month for each year of the retirant's or				
7	pensioner's credited service, if the person				
8	retired prior to July 1, 1965;				
9	(B) \$2.50 a month for each year of the retirant's or				
10	pensioner's credited service if the person				
11	retired after June 30, 1965, but prior to July 1,				
12	1970; and				
13	(C) \$1.00 a month for each year of the retirant's or				
14	pensioner's credited service if the person				
15	retired after June 30, 1970, but prior to July 1,

17	provided that if the retirants or pensioner had				
18	retired, returned to service, and again retired, the

7		a retirement allowance from the system or other
8		pension payable under or pursuant to the law of the
9		State or by any county or independent board or
10		commission, a special cost of living bonus, which
11		shall be paid in the following manner:
12		(A) \$.50 a month for each year of the retirant's or
13		pensioner's credited service if the person
14		retired after June 30, 1970, but prior to July 1
15		1975; and
16		(B) \$1.00 a month for each year of the retirant's or
17		pensioner's credited service if the person
18		retired after June 30, 1975, but prior to July 1
19		1979;
20		provided that if the retirant or pensioner had
21		retired, returned to service, and again retired, the
22		person's latest retirement date shall be considered as

1		the person's date of retirement; provided further that
2		no special cost of living bonus as provided for in
3		this paragraph shall be paid to those retirants or

6	(10)	Any other provision to the contrary notwithstanding,
7		effective July 1, 1988, there shall be paid to every
8		person who retired prior to July 1, 1982, and who on

10		from the system or other pension payable under or
11		pursuant to the law of the State or by any county or
12		independent board or commission, a special cost of
13		living bonus, which shall be paid in the following
14		manner:
15		(A) \$3.50 a month for each year of the retirant's or
16		pensioner's credited service, if the person
17		retired prior to July 1, 1965;
18		(B) \$2.50 a month for each year of the retirant's or
19		pensioner's credited service if the person
20		retired after June 30, 1965, but prior to July 1,
21		1970;

1		(C)	\$1.50 a month for each year of the retirant's or
2			pensioner's credited service if the person
3			retired after June 30, 1970, but prior to July 1,
4			1975; and
5		(D)	\$1.00 a month for each year of the retirant's or
6			pensioner's credited service if the person
7			retired after June 30, 1975, but prior to July 1,
8			1982;
9		prov	ided that if the retirant or pensioner had
10		reti	red, returned to service, and again retired, the
11		pers	on's latest retirement date shall be considered as
12		the	person's date of retirement; provided further that
13		no s	pecial cost of living bonus as provided for in
14		this	paragraph shall be paid to those retirants or
15		pens	ioners who have ten or less years of credited
16		serv	ice;
17	(11)	Any	other provision to the contrary notwithstanding,
18		effe	ctive July 1, 1990, and each July 1, thereafter
19		unti	l June 30, 1999, bonuses shall be paid to
20		reti	rants and pensioners with ten or more years of
21		serv	ice or to their beneficiaries who are receiving a
22		mont	hly benefit from the system, in accordance with

this paragraph; provided that the requirement of ten
or more years of service shall not apply in the case
of a person who retires with less than ten years of
service because of a service connected disability; and
provided further that if the retirant or pensioner is
currently receiving a larger bonus than what would be
payable under this paragraph the retirant or pensioner
shall continue to receive the bonus amount received on
June 30, 1990, until the retirant's or pensioner's
bonus calculated under this paragraph exceeds the June
30, 1990, bonus amount at which time the difference
between the June 30, 1990, bonus and the bonus
calculated under this paragraph would be payable.

The bonus amounts payable under this paragraph shall be based on years of retirement and shall be a cumulative amount to include all previous bonuses and shall not exceed:

(A) \$1.25 for each year of the retirant's or pensioner's credited service if the retirant or pensioner has been retired a minimum of five years by July 1 in the year in which the bonus is effective;

1	-20	(B)	\$2.50 for each year of the retirant's or
2			pensioner's credited service if the retirant or
3			pensioner has been retired a minimum of ten years
4			by July 1 in the year in which the bonus is
5			effective;
6		(C)	\$4.50 for each year of the retirant's or
7			pensioner's credited service if the retirant or
8			pensioner has been retired a minimum of fifteen
9			years by July 1 in the year in which the bonus is
10			effective;
11		(D)	\$6.00 for each year of the retirant's or
12			pensioner's credited service if the retirant or
13			pensioner has been retired a minimum of twenty
14			years by July 1 in the year in which the bonus is
15			effective;
16		(E)	\$8.75 for each year of the retirant's or
17			pensioner's credited service if the retirant or
18			pensioner has been retired a minimum of twenty-
19			five years by July 1 in the year in which the
20			bonus is effective;
21		(F)	\$10.50 for each year of the retirant's or

pensioner's credited service if the retirant or

1		pensioner has been retired a minimum of thirty
2		years by July 1 in the year in which the bonus is
3		effective;
4		(G) Any provision to the contrary notwithstanding,
5		any retirant or pensioner with ten or more years
6		of service who on July 1 of the year in which the
7		bonus is being calculated has been retired a
8		minimum of twenty years and whose current bonus
9		amount exceeds the maximum specified in this
10		paragraph shall nevertheless receive a pension
11		increase of \$1.25 for each year of credited
12		service.
13		For the purposes of this paragraph, if the retirant or
14		pensioner had retired, returned to service, and again
15		retired, the latest retirement date shall be
16		considered as the date of retirement; [and]
17	(12)	Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary,
18		in fiscal year 2002-2003, each state and county
19		retiree who is seventy years of age and older with at
20		least twenty years of credited service as of June 30,
21		2002, shall receive a one time, lump sum bonus of
22		\$200. Any lump sum bonus paid pursuant to this

1		paragraph shall not be construed to increase a
2		retirant's basic monthly pension accumulation or any
3		other post retirement benefit provided under this
4		chapter[-]; and
5	(13)	Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary,
6		in fiscal year 2008-2009, each state or county
7		retirant who is seventy-five years of age or older who
8		has at least twenty years of retirement as of June 30,
9		2008, shall receive a one-time, lump sum pension bonus
10		equal to a sum derived by adding up \$1 for every month
11		of every year of credited service earned by the
12		retirant. Any lump sum pension bonus paid pursuant to
13		this paragraph shall not be construed to increase a
14		retirant's basic monthly pension accumulation or any
15		other post retirement benefit provided under this
16		<pre>chapter."</pre>
17	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general	
18	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much	
19	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to provide	
20	retirants who are age seventy-five or older and who have been	
21	retired for at least twenty years as of June 30, 2008, a one-	
22	time, lump sum pension bonus equal to a sum derived by adding up

- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the employees'

- 7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
