13	(2)	Engaged in producing agricultural products where the
14		business is a producer as defined in section 237-5;
15	(3)	Engaged in research, development, sale, or production
16		of all types of genetically-engineered medical,
17		agricultural, or maritime biotechnology products; [or

1	(4)	Engaged in producing electric power from wind energy
2		for sale primarily to a public utility company for
3		resale to the public[-]; or
4	(5)	Engaged in advanced flight simulator training for
5		pilots, dispatchers, mechanics, or air traffic
6		controllers."
