A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the University of 2 Hawaii system is the only public postsecondary educational 3 institution in the state and, as such, maintains a tremendous responsibility in not only providing quality higher education to 4 5 its students, but also in being held accountable to the public. The legislature further finds that, recently, much of the 6 7 university's management and operations has been called into 8 question, including its current practice of preventing public 9 access to information on the potential salaries of new faculty 10 and executive/managerial positions and expenditures of the board of regents. Over the past few years, salaries of university 11 faculty and administrators have dramatically increased. They 12 13 have escalated to the point that approximately 473 faculty and 14 executive/managerial positions are currently paid salaries that exceed the salary of the governor of Hawaii, which makes the 15 matter one of statewide importance and concern. 16

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The purpose of this Act is to require the disclosure of:



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1	(1)	Information regarding compensation offered to newly	
2		hired employees;	
3	(2)	Changes in compensation offered to existing employees	
4		for executive/managerial positions in the University	
5		of Hawaii system filled by excluded employees; and	
6	(3)	All budgetary expenditures made by the board of	
7		regents.	
8	SECTION 2. Section 89C-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
9	amended to read as follows:		
10	"§890	C-4 Adjustments for excluded employees exempt from	
11	civil service. Each appropriate authority shall determine the		
12	adjustments that are relevant for their respective excluded		
13	employees who are exempt from civil service in consideration of		
14	the compensation and benefit packages provided for other		
15	employees in comparable agencies. For executive/managerial		
16	positions in the University of Hawaii system filled by excluded		
17	employees, proposed compensation or change in compensation shall		
18	be disclosed in open meeting for purposes of public comment."		
19	SECTION 3. Section 304A-105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
20	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:		
21	"(a) The board of regents shall have management and		
22	control of	the general affairs, and exclusive jurisdiction over	
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1	the internal structure, management, and operation of the		
2	universit	y. The board may [appoint]:	
3	(1)	Appoint a treasurer and other officers as it deems	
4		necessary[. The board may authorize];	
5	(2)	Authorize any officer, elected or appointed by it, to	
6		approve and sign on its behalf any voucher or other	
7		document that the board may approve and sign[. The	
8		<pre>board may delegate];</pre>	
9	(3)	Delegate to the president or the president's designee	
10		the authority to render the final decision in	
11		contested case proceedings subject to chapter 91, as	
12		it deems appropriate[. The board may purchase];	
13	(4)	Purchase or otherwise acquire lands, buildings,	
14		appliances, and other property for the purposes of the	
15		university [and expend such]; and	
16	(5)	Expend any sums of money as, from time to time, may be	
17		placed at the disposal of the university from whatever	
18		source $[-;]$; provided that notwithstanding any other law	
19		to the contrary, all documents regarding expenditures	
20		and changes thereto, made by the board shall be	
21		disclosed in open meetings for the purpose of public	
22		comment; provided further that all expenditure	
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requests, proposals, and any other budgetary documents
used by the board at an open meeting shall be made
available to the public at least six calendar days
before the meeting.

5 All lands, buildings, appliances, and other property so 6 purchased or acquired shall be and remain the property of the 7 university to be used in perpetuity for the benefit of the 8 university. The board, in accordance with this section and 9 other law, shall manage the inventory, equipment, surplus 10 property, and expenditures of the university and, subject to 11 chapter 91, may adopt rules, further controlling and regulating 12 the same."

13 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Description:

Requires the University of Hawaii board of regents to publicly disclose in open meetings: (1) compensation offered to newly hired employees; (2) changes in compensation offered to existing employees for administrative positions in the UH system filled by excluded employees; and (3) all budgetary expenditures made by the board of regents.
