A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GRAFFITI.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 577-3.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) In addition to any other lawful orders, if a minor is
4	found under chapter 571 to have committed an act constituting
5	graffiti, the court [may order the minor, the parents, or the
6	legal guardians of the minor to pay the actual cost of having
7	the damaged property repaired or replaced] shall:
8	(1) Require the minor, the parents, or the legal guardians
9	to remove the graffiti from the affected property
10	within sixty days of the order and pay for the cost of
11	<pre>paint and materials; and [may order]</pre>
12	(2) Order the minor to perform a minimum of eighty hours
13	of community service[+] to remove graffiti from other
14	properties.
15	[If the court orders payment for the actual cost of the damage,
16	the court shall give due consideration to the financial
17	resources of the minor, the parents, or the legal guardians of

- 1 the damage. If the court determines that the minor, the
- 2 parents, or the legal guardians of the minor are unable to pay
- 3 the actual cost of the damage, the court may order payment in an
- 4 amount for which they are able to pay or in a manner in which
- 5 they are able to pay, and may order the minor to perform
- 6 community service work in an amount commensurate with the costs
- 7 of the damage for which they are unable to pay.] "

Description:
