A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that an estimated 6,000 2 children in the State of Hawaii have a parent in prison. Many 3 children of incarcerated parents experience grief, guilt, shame, 4 fear, depression, and have difficulty sleeping or concentrating. 5 Although children need to maintain contact with their parent, 6 visits at correctional facilities can be frightening for some 7 children.

8 The purpose of this Act is to help maintain the well-being9 of children of incarcerated parents and support their needs.

10 SECTION 2. Chapter 577, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 12 and to read as follows:

13 "<u>§577-</u> Bill of rights for children of incarcerated

14 parents. Children of incarcerated parents shall be afforded 15 rights, which shall include the right:

16 (1) To be kept safe and informed at the time of the
17 parent's arrest;

3	(4)	To be well cared for in the incarcerated parent's

9	(7)	To not be judged, blamed, or labeled because of the
10		parent's incarceration; and
11	(8)	To have a lifelong relationship with the parent."
