A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RENTAL MOTOR VEHICLE SURCHARGE TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 251-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) There is levied and shall be assessed and collected
4	each month a rental motor vehicle surcharge tax of \$2 a day,
5	except that for the period of September 1, 1999, to August 31,
6	[2008, 2009] the tax shall be \$3 a day, or any portion of a day
7	that a rental motor vehicle is rented or leased. The rental
8	motor vehicle surcharge tax shall be levied upon the lessor;
9 ,	provided that the tax shall not be levied on the lessor if:
10	(1) The lessor is renting the vehicle to replace a vehicle
11	of the lessee that is being repaired; and
12	(2) A record of the repair order for the vehicle is
13	retained either by the lessor for two years for
14	verification purposes or by a motor vehicle repair
15	dealer for two years as provided in section 437B-16."
16	SECTION 2. (a) The department of transportation shall
17	study the financial requirements of the state highway fund, with

- 1 an emphasis of the adequacy and equity of revenues generated by
- 2 one or more revenue sources pursuant to section 251-2, Hawaii
- 3 Revised Statutes, compared with other revenue sources
- 4 contributing to or that could be contributing to the highway
- 5 fund.
- **6** (b) The study may include discussions and meetings with
- 7 representatives of different interest groups and present
- 8 contributors of revenues to the highway fund.
- 9 (c) The study may include a review of:
- 10 (1) Past, present, and projected revenues of the state
- 11 highway fund;
- 12 (2) The ability of the department of transportation to
- plan, implement, and expend funds on a timely basis;
- 14 (3) An analysis of the actual revenue needs of the
- department of transportation;
- 16 (4) Other revenue sources of the state highway fund and
- 17 their nexus to the fund; and
- 18 (5) Other governmental matching funds.
- 19 (d) The study shall include data from the 2000-2001 fiscal
- 20 year to the present fiscal year and may include any data,
- 21 information, or conclusions by task forces or groups that have
- 22 discussed or met in the past to evaluate at least in part the

- 1 fiscal needs, revenue sources, or viability of the state highway
- 2 fund.
- 3 (e) The department of transportation shall submit a final
- 4 report, including proposed legislation for increasing revenue
- 5 sources for the state highway fund to meet its ongoing and
- 6 future needs, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 7 to the convening of the regular session of 2009.
- 8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
