A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The purposes of this Act are to:
2	(1)	Clarify the office of environmental quality control's
3		role and authority to coordinate, at the earliest time
4		possible, the requirements and responsibilities of a
5		state or county agency to conduct an environmental
6		review when two or more state or county agencies have
7		jurisdiction over a proposed action; and
8	(2)	Clarify the rule-making authority of the environmental
9		council.
10	SECT	ION 2. Section 343-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11	amended b	y amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
12	"(d)	Whenever an applicant [simultaneously] requests
13	approval	for a proposed action [from two or more agencies] and
14	there is	a question as to which [agency] of two or more state or
15	county ag	encies with jurisdiction has the responsibility of
16	preparing	the environmental assessment, the office, after
17	consultat	ion with [the agencies involved,] and assistance from

the affected state or county agencies, shall determine which 1 agency shall prepare the assessment." 2 SECTION 3. Section 343-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 3 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 4 "[(a) After consultation with the affected agencies, the 5 council shall adopt, amend, or repeal necessary rules for the 6 purposes of this chapter in accordance with chapter 91 7 including, but not limited to, rules which shall: 8 9 (1) Prescribe the contents of an environmental impact 10 statement; (2) Prescribe the procedures whereby a group of proposed 11 actions may be treated by a single statement; 12 (3) Prescribe procedures for the preparation and contents 13 of an environmental assessment; 14 (4) Prescribe procedures for the submission, distribution, 15 16 review, acceptance or nonacceptance, and withdrawal of 17 a statement; (5) Prescribe procedures to appeal the nonacceptance of a 18 statement to the environmental council: 19 (6) Establish criteria to determine whether a statement is 20 21 acceptable or not;

Environmental Assessments; Exemptions

Description:

Clarifies that when 2 or more agencies have jurisdiction, the office of environmental quality control shall determine which agency has the responsibility of preparing an environmental assessment after consultation with and assistance from the affected state or county agencies. Makes clarifications to the rulemaking powers of the environmental council. (SB2808 HD1)
