

2808 S.D. 2 H.D. 1 PROPOSED

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 343-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
3	"(d) Whenever an applicant [simultaneously] requests
4	approval for a proposed action [from two or more agencies] and
5	there is a question as to which [agency] of two or more state or
6	county agencies with jurisdiction has the responsibility of
7	preparing the environmental assessment, the office, after
8	consultation with [the agencies involved,] and assistance from
9	the affected state or county agencies, shall determine which
10	agency shall prepare the assessment."
11	SECTION 2. Section 343-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
13	"[(a) After consultation with the affected agencies, the
14	council shall adopt, amend, or repeal necessary rules for the
15	purposes of this chapter in accordance with chapter 91
16	including, but not limited to, rules which shall:

1	(1)	Prescribe the contents of an environmental impact
2		statement;
3	(2)	Prescribe the procedures whereby a group of proposed
4		actions may be treated by a single statement;
5	(3)	Prescribe procedures for the preparation and contents
6		of an environmental assessment;
7	(4)	Prescribe procedures for the submission, distribution,
8		review, acceptance or nonacceptance, and withdrawal of
9		a statement;
10	(5)	Prescribe procedures to appeal the nonacceptance of a
11		statement to the environmental council;
12	(6)	Establish criteria to determine whether a statement is
13		acceptable or not;
14	(7)	Establish procedures whereby specific types of
15		actions, because they will probably have minimal or no
16		significant effects on the environment, are declared
17		exempt from the preparation of an assessment;
18	(8)	Prescribe procedures for informing the public of
19		determinations that a statement is either required or
20		not required, for informing the public of the
21		availability of draft statements for review and
22		comments, and for informing the public of the

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1		acceptance or nonacceptance of the final statement;
2		and
3	(9)	Prescribe the contents of an environmental
4		assessment.]

12	(9)	Prescribe procedures to appeal the nonacceptance of ar
13		environmental statement to the environmental council.

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Report Title:

Environmental Assessments; Exemptions

Description:

Clarifies that when 2 or more agencies have jurisdiction, the office of environmental quality control shall determine which agency has the responsibility of preparing an environmental assessment after consultation with and assistance from the affected state or county agencies. Makes clarifications to the rulemaking powers of the environmental council. (PROPOSED HD1)
