1 (b) The state procurement office, in cooperation with the 2 department of human resources development, shall develop and 3 maintain a procurement practices training and development program for procurement officers of the State and the several 4 5 counties. Attendance shall be mandatory for state procurement officers as determined by the state procurement office to ensure 6 7 that an agency's procurement practices are in compliance with 8 the procurement code and that proper procurement decisions are 9 made consistent with this chapter. Attendance by county 10 procurement officials shall be elective."
