BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Allows the Hawaii Community Development Authority to sell reserved housing units as defined in section 206E-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, in fee simple. Requires sold units to remain affordable in perpetuity. (SB2982 HD2)
