15		of the portion withdrawn and the developer shall be
16		entitled to receive from the department the
17		proportionate value of the developer's permanent
18		improvements so taken in the proportion that they bear

1	to the unexpired term of the agreement, with the value
2	of the permanent improvements determined on the basis
3	of fair market value or depreciated value, whichever
4	is less; or the developer, in the alternative, may
5	remove and relocate the developer's improvements to
6	the remainder of the lands occupied by the developer."
7	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
9	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
