## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the recent changes
2	to the federal temporary assistance for needy families program
3	rules and subsequent first-to-work program changes, which limit
4	educational activities to two years of study leading to
5	vocational or technical degrees in order to meet federal work
6	requirements, grandfathers currently participating students and
7	allows them to finish their education. For example, first-to-
8	work participating students who are pursuing a baccalaureate
9	degree are transferred to the state-funded bridge-to-hope
10	program to continue their studies.
11	However, new federal temporary assistance for needy
12	families program first-to-work participating students are
13	restricted to the new two-year education activity option to
14	receive vocational or technical degrees. In other words, these
15	students may not continue to pursue a four-year baccalaureate
16	degree, and favorite areas of study such as pre-nursing will no

1 longer be available to them, without violating federal work 2 rules. 3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the 4 bridge to hope program to enable heads of households receiving 5 financial assistance and participating in the first-to-work 6 programs to pursue educational activities beyond the new two-7 year federal limit by transferring them to the state-funded 8 bridge to hope program. 9 SECTION 2. Section 346-68, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 11 "(a) There is created within the department a post-12 secondary education benefits program, to be known as the bridge 13 to hope program, for heads of households receiving financial 14 assistance and participating in the [temporary assistance to 15 needy families program.] first-to-work programs. 16 To receive assistance under this program, the [single] 17 parent shall: 18 Be enrolled as a student each term [+] in an approved (1) 19 course of study; provided that the approved course of 20 study shall not be limited to vocational education;

Maintain passing grades or better throughout the

course of study; and

   department."
   SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
- 6 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 7 year 2008-2009, for the bridge to hope program to enable heads
- 8 of households receiving financial assistance and participating
- 9 in the first-to-work programs to pursue educational activities
- 10 beyond the new two-year federal limit by transferring them to
- 11 the state-funded bridge to hope program.
- 12 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 13 of human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval,
- 17 except that section 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2007.



### Report Title:

Bridge to Hope; Educational Activities

#### Description:

Appropriates funds for the bridge to hope program to enable heads of households receiving financial assistance and participating in the first-to-work programs to pursue educational activities beyond the new two-year federal limit. (SD1)
