BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
2	adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
3	as follows:
4	"CHAPTER
5	INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS PROTOCOL
6	"\$ -1 Legislative protocol fund; international affairs.
7	(a) There is established a legislative protocol fund to be
8	administered by the legislature.
9	(b) Appropriations made by the legislature shall be
10	deposited into the fund.
11	(c) The fund shall be used to extend protocol courtesies
12	to visiting international dignitaries and government officials."
13	SECTION 2. Section 201-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	"[+]\$201-17[+] Office of international affairs;
16	established. (a) There is established, within the department

3	(b)	The office shall:	
4	(1)	Develop policies that promote and strengthen relations

9	(3)	Develop and promote international telecommunications	
10		and high technology exchanges;	
11	(4)	Encourage the development of international sister-city

13		globe for artistic, cultural, economic, educational,	
14		and faith-based exchanges;	
15	(5)	Develop and promote Hawaii as the economic, trade,

9		accountability in international affairs and serve as
10		the state's advocate for a global orientation;
11	<u>(9)</u>	Inventory existing international programs and develop
12		a web-based information portal to make this
13		information available to the public;
14	(10)	Encourage the holding of international conferences in
15		Hawaii;
16	(11)	Encourage the development of international programming
17		and content on local radio shows and a dedicated
18		public access channel for international programs and
19		issues; and
20	(12)	Encourage the holding of international sporting events
21		and competitions in Hawaii.

[(c) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, if any 1 of the responsibilities or duties of the office of international 2 affairs under this section overlap with the responsibilities or 3 4 duties of another agency or authority under this chapter, the office of international affairs shall have exclusive 5 jurisdiction and authority over those responsibilities and duties. " 7 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to 10 11 hire an executive director and an administrative assistant for the office of international affairs and for operating and 12 13 program expenses. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 14 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of 15 16 this Act.
