A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PHOTOVOLTAIC ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature is in support of renewable
energy programs to reduce dependence on imported fossil fuels
and to promote the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions, while
increasing energy security by minimizing the impacts of supply
disruptions and pricing volatility.

6 The legislature finds that the high initial cost of 7 purchasing renewable energy systems is a barrier to the 8 installation and utilization of these types of technologies. 9 The legislature also finds that the renewable energy income tax 10 credit, the high cost of electricity, and other market-based 11 incentives may not be sufficient to encourage, in particular, 12 the use of photovoltaic systems throughout Hawaii.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to encourage and authorize the public utilities commission to establish a ratepayer-funded photovoltaic rebate program to promote the use of this renewable energy technology to utility customers within electric utility service areas, if the public utilities
