A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
FOR THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND INJURY PREVENTION
SYSTEM BRANCH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
3 the Hawaii Constitution.

4 SECTION 2. Although funds were appropriated to the
5 department of health for emergency medical services for the
6 fiscal period beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008,
7 a critical funding emergency now exists.

8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate an additional
\$507,539 in general funds and \$1,300,000 in special funds for
10 fiscal year 2007-2008 to pay for ambulance service contract
11 collective bargaining costs. This emergency appropriation is
12 necessary to comply with collective bargaining increases
13 negotiated by the ambulance service provider for Oahu.

14 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$507,539 or so much
16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 to comply
17 with collective bargaining increases negotiated by the ambulance


1 service provider for Oahu; provided that these funds shall not
2 be used for any purpose other than the collective bargaining
3 increases.

4 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the emergency
5 medical services special fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
6 \$1,300,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
7 year 2007-2008 to comply with the collective bargaining
8 increases negotiated by the ambulance service provider for Oahu;
9 provided that these funds shall not be used for any purpose
10 other than the collective bargaining increases.

11 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated in sections 3 and 4 shall
12 be expended by the department of health.

13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
