BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 Section 132D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "display fireworks" to 3 read as follows: 4 ""Display fireworks" means any fireworks designed primarily 5 for exhibition display by producing visible or audible effects 6 and classified as display fireworks or contained in the
- 7 regulations of the United States Department of Transportation
- and designated as UN0333, UN0334, or UN0335, and includes
- 9 salutes containing more than two grains (one hundred and thirty
- 10 milligrams) of explosive materials, aerial shells containing
- 11 more than forty grams of pyrotechnic compositions, and other
- 12 display pieces which exceed the limits of explosive materials
- 13 for classification as "consumer fireworks". This term also
- 14 includes fused setpieces containing components, which together
- 15 exceed fifty milligrams of salute power. The use of display
- 16 fireworks shall be prohibited for use by any person who does not
- 17 have a display permit issued by a county."
