A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII RULES OF EVIDENCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 626-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding to Article IV a new rule to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "Rule Admissibility of expressions of sympathy and
- 5 condolence. Evidence of statements or gestures that express
- 6 sympathy, commiseration, or condolence concerning the
- 7 consequences of an event in which the declarant was a
- 8 participant is not admissible to prove liability for any claim
- 9 growing out of the event. This rule does not require the
- 10 exclusion of an apology or other statement that acknowledges or
- 11 implies fault even though contained in, or part of, any
- 12 statement or gesture excludable under this rule."
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect the rights or duties
- 14 that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that
- 15 were begun, before its effective date.
- 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.



Report Title:

Evidence of statements or gestures expressing sympathy, commiseration or condolence.

Description:

Renders evidence of statements or gestures expressing sympathy, commiseration, or condolence concerning consequences of an event inadmissible to establish civil liability. Statements of apology or fault remain admissible. (SD1)
