## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ORGAN DONOR REGISTRY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 "PART . ORGAN DONOR REGISTRY
- 5 §321- Organ donor registry; established; department
- 6 responsibility. (a) There is established the statewide organ
- 7 donor registry within the department of health that shall serve
- 8 as a centralized database and automated system to make organ
- 9 donor information available to family members and physicians
- 10 seven days a week, twenty-four hours per day. The registry
- 11 shall be used to compile the organ donation information received
- 12 by the department of health, the department of transportation,
- 13 the county motor vehicle agencies, attorneys, organ donation
- 14 awareness programs, and others.
- (b) The director of health may contract for the
- 16 establishment of the statewide organ donor registry.
- 17 (c) The director of health shall work with the department
- 18 of transportation, county motor vehicle agencies, the Organ

- 1 Donor Center of Hawaii, and any other interested parties in
- 2 developing specifications for the registry. In developing these
- 3 specifications, consideration shall be given to implementing an
- 4 automated toll-free hotline."
- 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 8 establishment of a statewide organ donor registry.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
