A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII PENAL CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 706-668.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 3 "(1) If multiple terms of imprisonment are imposed on a
- 4 defendant, whether at the same time[τ] or at different times, or
- 5 if a term of imprisonment is imposed on a defendant who is
- 6 already subject to an unexpired term of imprisonment, the terms
- 7 may run concurrently or consecutively. Multiple terms of
- 8 imprisonment [imposed at the same time] run concurrently unless
- 9 the court orders or the statute mandates that the terms run
- 10 consecutively. [Multiple terms of imprisonment imposed at
- 11 different times run consecutively unless the court orders that
- 12 the terms run concurrently.] "
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act shall apply to all terms of
- 14 imprisonment imposed on or after January 1, 2009.
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
