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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 444-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 **"§444-3 Contractors license board.** (a) There shall be a  
4 contractors license board of thirteen members.

5 (b) Of the board members:

6 (1) Ten shall be contractors who have been actively  
7 engaged in the contracting business for a period of  
8 not less than five years preceding the date of their  
9 appointment;

10 (2) Five shall be general engineering or building  
11 contractors, five shall be specialty contractors, and  
12 three shall be noncontractors[-];

13 (3) At least three shall be appointed from a list of  
14 nominees submitted by the speaker of the house of  
15 representatives; and

16 (4) At least three shall be appointed from a list of  
17 nominees submitted by the president of the senate.



1 No member shall receive any compensation for the member's  
2 services, but each shall be reimbursed for necessary traveling  
3 expenses incurred in the performance of duties.

4 (c) Each county shall be represented on the board.

5 (d) No one, except the three noncontractor members, shall  
6 be eligible for appointment who does not at the time of the  
7 member's appointment hold a valid and unexpired license to  
8 operate as a contractor."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
