A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the mission of the
- 2 center on aging research and education is to assure the well-
- 3 being of the State's older adults by stimulating and
- 4 coordinating gerontological and aging instruction, research, and
- 5 community services. The legislature further finds that a goal
- 6 of the center on aging research and education is to develop a
- 7 research center that is renowned for its generation of knowledge
- 8 that supports the development of relevant social and economic
- 9 policies pertaining to the elder population, as no such entity
- 10 exists in Hawaii or the region.
- 11 Currently, there is an urgent need to engage in
- 12 gerontological research given the radical demographic shifts
- 13 related to the growing aging population in Hawaii and in Asia
- 14 and the Pacific.
- 15 However, reliable general funding is necessary to attract
- 16 renowned scholars from the Asian and Pacific regions and
- 17 nationally to study the aging phenomenon and serve to train

- 1 professionals for work in the field of gerontology. The
- 2 legislature believes that, given proper staffing levels, the
- 3 center on aging research and education can become a viable
- 4 research and training center for addressing local and Asian and
- 5 Pacific regional issues.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to establish five additional
- 7 faculty positions at the center on aging research and education
- 8 to assist the center in the fulfillment of its mission, and to
- 9 appropriate funds for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 2. The University of Hawaii shall establish five
- 11 additional faculty positions at the center on aging research and
- 12 education to assist the center on aging research and education
- 13 in the fulfillment of its mission.
- 14 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$350,000, or so much
- 16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the
- 17 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 18 2008-2009, for five additional faculty positions to staff the
- 19 center on aging research and education.
- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
- 21 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
