A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL LICENSING FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 92-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§92-28 State service fees; increase or decrease of. Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the fees or other nontax 4 revenues assessed or charged by any board, commission, or other 5 governmental agency may be increased or decreased by the body in 6 an amount not to exceed fifty per cent of the statutorily 7 assessed fee or nontax revenue, to maintain a reasonable 8 relation between the revenues derived from such fee or nontax 9 revenue and the cost or value of services rendered, 10 11 comparability among fees imposed by the State, or any other purpose which it may deem necessary and reasonable; provided 12 13 that:
- 14 (1)The authority to increase or decrease fees or nontax revenues shall be subject to the approval of the 15 governor and extend only to the following: chapters 16 36, 92, 94, 142, 144, 145, 147, 150, 171, 188, 189, 17 231, 269, 271, 321, 338, 373, 412, 414, 414D, 415A, 18

- (5) The authority to increase or decrease fees or nontax revenues pursuant to this section shall be exempt from the public notice and public hearing requirements of chapter 91; and
- (6) Fees for copies of proposed and final rules and public notices of proposed rulemaking actions under chapter 91 shall not exceed 10 cents a page, as required by section 91-2.5."
- SECTION 2. The licensed professions and vocations included in section 92-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, by section 1 of this Act shall be subject to the authority provided under that section to any board, commission, or other governmental body under the department of commerce and consumer affairs only to the extent that any board, commission, or other governmental body under the department of commerce and consumer affairs may decrease, not increase, any fee or nontax revenue assessed or charged pursuant to the respective licensing laws governing each licensed profession or vocation.

- 22 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
