A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC SITES.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted and to read as follows: 3 ""Potential native Hawaiian historic site" means a wall, 4 platform, stone pavement, enclosure, terrace, petroglyph, heiau, 5 mound, ahu, auwai, trail, shrine, or any other feature of human 6 7 origin that is consistent in design and construction materials to features built by native Hawaiians before 1850, and for which 8 there is no credible evidence demonstrating that it was built 9 10 after 1850."
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 12 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 "S6E- Native Hawaiian historic sites. (a) No
- 15 landowner, or any person with the consent of the landowner, may
- 16 remove, excavate, injure, or destroy a potential native Hawaiian
- 17 historic site on private property, unless the landowner has
- 18 notified the department of the proposed action and of the future

- 1 use the landowner proposes for the potential native Hawaiian
- 2 historic site. The department shall have not more than sixty
- 3 days from receipt of the notice to review and comment upon the
- 4 proposed action.
- 5 (b) After the department's review and comment, the
- 6 department may approve the proposed action, if the department
- 7 finds that the site in question does not warrant preservation.
- 8 If the department approves the proposed action, the landowner
- 9 shall apply for any land use approval required if the proposed
- 10 use of the property would require a permit, license,
- 11 certificate, land use change, subdivision, or other entitlement
- 12 for use issued by the State or any of its political
- 13 subdivisions, and shall comply with the procedures established
- 14 under section 6E-42.
- 15 (c) If the department does not approve the proposed
- 16 action, the landowner shall record a covenant running with the
- 17 land, with a copy sent to the department, that the landowner
- 18 will not apply for a permit, license, certificate, land use
- 19 change, subdivision, or other entitlement for use issued by the
- 20 State or any of its political subdivisions affecting the land
- 21 containing the potential native Hawaiian historic site, for ten
- 22 years from the date of recordation.

| 20 | violation. For the purposes of this section, a landowner shall |
| 21 | be deemed to have constructive knowledge of sites listed in the |
| 22 | state inventory of historic places." |
