RELATING TO ELDER ABUSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 28-94, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending the definition of "caregiver" to read as 2 3 follows: ""Caregiver" means any person who has undertaken the care, 4 custody, or physical control of [or] a dependent elder, 5 6 including, but not limited to, compensated or uncompensated 7 family members or other relatives, or any person who has a legal 8 or contractual duty to care for the health, safety, and welfare of a dependent elder, including, but not limited to, owners, 9 operators, employees, or staff of: 10 11 (1) Hospitals; 12 (2) Hospices; 13 (3) Adult residential care homes; 14 (4) Developmentally disabled domiciliary homes; 15 (5) Developmentally disabled adult foster homes; (6) Intermediate care facilities; 16 17 Skilled nursing facilities; (7)
