A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Based on extensive analysis, the Hawaii housing
- 2 finance and development corporation has concluded that any
- 3 negotiated solution with Kukui Gardens Corporation or Carmel
- 4 Partners, or the Kukui Gardens residents resulting in
- 5 preservation of the current levels of affordability at Kukui
- 6 Gardens will require some level of state financial subsidy.
- 7 Kukui Gardens units are in need of repair and rehabilitation.
- $oldsymbol{8}$ The legislature finds that in all potential solutions, net of
- 9 the use of the State's low income housing tax credit and tax
- 10 exempt revenue bond financing, a financial gap will remain to
- 11 enable Kukui Gardens to remain an affordable development. The
- 12 magnitude of this gap will depend on the terms of the
- 13 transaction and its structure.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys to fund
- 15 the gap and allow Kukui Gardens to remain an affordable
- 16 development.
- 17 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so SB LRB 07-1777.doc



- much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and 1
- the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 2
- 3 year 2008-2009, for the purposes of section 1 of this Act.
- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 4
- of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes 5
- of this Act. 6

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
