A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 431:10C-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 1 2 is amended to read as follows: "\$431:10C-107 Verification of insurance: motor vehicles. 3 Every insurer shall issue to its insureds a sticker and a 4 motor vehicle insurance identification card for each motor 5 6 vehicle for which the basic motor vehicle insurance coverage is written. The identification card shall contain the following: 7 Name of make and factory or serial number of the motor 8 (1)9 vehicle; provided that insurers of five or more motor 10 vehicles which are under common registered ownership and used in the regular course of business shall not 11 12 be required to indicate the name of make and the factory or serial number of each motor vehicle; 13 14 (2)Policy number; 15 (3)Names of the insured and the insurer; and 16 (4)Effective dates of coverage including the expiration 17 date.

- 1 (b) The identification card shall be in the insured motor
- 2 vehicle at all times and shall be exhibited to a law enforcement
- 3 officer upon demand. The sticker shall be affixed to the
- 4 vehicle.
- 5 (c) The identification card and the sticker shall be
- 6 resistant to forgery by whatever means appropriate. The
- 7 commissioner shall approve the construction, form, and design of
- 8 the identification card and sticker to ensure that the card and
- 9 the sticker is forgery resistant.
- 10 (d) The commissioner shall issue a sticker and certificate

- (e) The identification card and sticker issued by an
