A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to allow the various
- 2 counties to enact more stringent fireworks laws than those
- 3 imposed by chapter 132D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 "S132D-17 Inconsistent county ordinances, rules.
- 7 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no county shall
- 8 enact ordinances or adopt any rules regulating fireworks or
- 9 articles pyrotechnic [, except as required in this chapter,] that
- 10 [is] are inconsistent with [or more restrictive than, the
- 11 provisions of this chapter[-]; provided that the ordinances or
- 12 rules may be more stringent than this chapter. Any ordinances
- 13 and rules regulating fireworks or articles pyrotechnic that were
- 14 enacted or adopted by a county before March 31, 1995, except
- 15 those [provisions which] that are not inconsistent with[, or
- 16 more restrictive than those of this chapter, are declared
- 17 void."

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
