A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 132D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended to read as follows: 2 3 "§132D-3 Permissible uses of consumer fireworks[-]; and prohibitions. (a) Consumer fireworks may be set off, ignited, 4 discharged, or otherwise caused to explode within the State 5 6 only: From 9:00 p.m. on New Year's Eve to 1:00 a.m. on New 7 (1)8 Year's Day; from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Chinese New 9 Year's Day; and from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on the Fourth of July; or 10 From 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. as allowed by permit 11 (2) pursuant to section 132D-10 if the proposed cultural 12 13 use is to occur at any time other than during the periods prescribed in paragraph (1); 14 provided that the purchase of not more than five thousand 15 individual consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers 16 shall be allowed under each permit. 17

2	fireworks on the Fourth of July in counties with populations
3	over 500,000."
