A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TUITION ASSISTANCE.

RE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 121-45, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2 The adjutant general, subject to the availability of 3 funds, may award tuition assistance to qualified enlisted 4 persons, warrant officers, and [company grade] officers [(0-1 5 through 0-3)] in the Hawaii national guard who are: 6 Residents of the State, as defined by the board of 7 (1) regents pursuant to section [{]304A-402[}]; and 8 [Undergraduate students] Students working toward a 9 (2) degree on any campus of the University of Hawaii." 10 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009, to 13 provide tuition assistance to members of the Hawaii national 14 quard who are students working toward a degree on any campus of 15 16 the University of Hawaii system.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of defense for the purposes of this Act.
