A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEEWARD COAST IMPROVEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$4,666,609, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2007-2008, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the twenty-first senatorial district, as follows:
- 7 1. Leihoku elementary school
- 8 A. Design and construction
- 9 for air conditioning
- 10 for classrooms and cafeteria. \$500,000
- 11 B. Design and construction
- 12 of a chain link fence along
- 13 the northern perimeter of
- 14 the school. \$10,000
- 15 Total funding \$510,000
- 16 2. Nanaikapono elementary school
- 17 Design and construction


1 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
8 department of education for the purposes of this Act; provided
9 that the sum appropriated in item 6 shall be expended by the
10 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of
11 this Act.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
