A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 302A-443, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) An impartial hearing may be requested by any parent
4	or guardian of a child with a disability, or by the department,
5	on any matter relating to the identification, evaluation,
6	program, or placement of a child with a disability; provided
7	that the hearing is requested:
8	(1) Within two years of the date the parent, guardian, or
9	department knew or should have known about the alleged
10	action that formed the basis of the request for a
11	hearing; and
12	(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), within [ninety days]
13	one hundred and eighty calendar days of a unilateral
14	special education placement, where the request is for
15	reimbursement of the costs of the placement."
