A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general 1 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ much thereof as may be necessary, for defraying any and all 3 session and nonsession expenses of the senate up to and 4 5 including June 30, 2009, including the 2008 regular session, 6 twenty-fourth legislature of the State of Hawaii, and pre-session expenses and the expenses of any committee or 7 committees established during the interim between the 2008 and 8 2009 regular sessions. 9 10 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by 11 the senate. 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so 14 much thereof as may be necessary, for defraying any and all 15 session and nonsession expenses of the house of representatives up to and including June 30, 2009, including the 2008 regular 16

session, twenty-fourth legislature of the State of Hawaii, and

- 1 pre-session expenses and the expenses of any committee or
- 2 committees established during the interim between the 2008 and
- 3 2009 regular sessions.
- 4 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 5 the house of representatives.
- 6 SECTION 3. Payment of expenses of the senate during the
- 7 interim between the 2008 and 2009 regular sessions shall be made
- 8 only with the approval of the president of the senate, and
- 9 payment of expenses of the house of representatives during the
- 10 interim between the 2008 and 2009 sessions shall be made only
- 11 with the approval of the speaker of the house of
- 12 representatives.
- 13 SECTION 4. Before January 21, 2009, the senate and the
- 14 house of representatives shall each have their accounts audited
- 15 and a full report of the respective audits shall be presented to
- 16 the senate and to the house of representatives convening on
- 17 January 21, 2009.
- 18 SECTION 5. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, the
- 19 expenses of any member of the legislature while traveling abroad
- 20 on official business of the legislature shall be \$130 a day as
- 21 authorized by the president of the senate and the speaker of the
- 22 house of representatives, respectively.

- 5 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary, to the office of the ombudsman
- 8 for defraying the expenses of the office during fiscal year
- 9 2008-2009.
- 10 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 11 the ombudsman.
- 12 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums, or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary, for defraying the expenses of the
- 15 legislative information system:
- 16 (1) \$ to the senate; and
- 17 (2) \$ to the house of representatives.
- 18 This appropriation shall be used to pay for hardware, software,
- 19 consultant, installation, material, supply, and other related
- 20 costs associated with the legislative information system that
- 21 have been or will be incurred.

- 1 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary, for the legislative broadcast
- 4 program, including the production and distribution of television
- 5 broadcasts of legislative proceedings.
- 6 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 7 the legislature for the purposes of this section.
- 8 SECTION 13. Except for moneys in the audit revolving fund,
- 9 as of the close of business on June 30, 2009, the unexpended or
- 10 unencumbered balance of any appropriation made by this Act shall
- 11 lapse into the general fund.
- 12 SECTION 14. Each section of this Act is declared to be
- 13 severable from the remainder of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
