A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that during the 2006 2 legislative session, legislation was passed directing the Hawaii 3 employees' retirement system to conduct an actuarial study to 4 analyze possible improvements in order to account for the 5 effects of inflation. The actuarial study indicated that the fairest and most equitable option, among suggested options, was 6 the option that addresses the concerns of retirees by: 7 8 (1)Factoring in how many years the retiree has been in 9 retirement; and 10 (2) Recognizing how many years of service the retiree has 11 rendered to the State. 12 The legislature finds that the last ad hoc increase provided by the employees' retirement system was during the
- provided by the employees' retirement system was during the 2002-2003 fiscal year. That increase was a one-time, lump sum, pension bonus for retirees age seventy-five and older, with twenty or more years of service.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to help offset the

1	similar one-time, lump sum payment available only to retirees
2	who are at least seventy-five years of age and who have been in
3	retirement for at least twenty years. The payment provided by
4	this Act to certain older retirees is a one time, lump sum
5	payment and is not intended to provide an enhanced pension
6	benefit.
7	SECTION 2. Section 88-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	"§88-11 Bonus; pensioners' special compensation; amounts
10	available. Except as herein provided, every pension payable
11	under the employees' retirement system or payable pursuant to
12	any law of the State, or by any county or independent public
13	board or commission, shall be increased by a bonus for each
14	month as follows:
15	(1) Effective July 1, 1976, \$77.82 per month to those
16	retirants and pensioners who had, before July 1, 1966,
17	ten or more years of service; provided that any member
18	who is retired because of physical or mental
19	disability due to any injury or disease incurred while
20	in the performance of the member's duty as a public
21	employee shall be entitled to receive the bonus

until June 30, 1999, bonuses shall be paid to
retirants and pensioners with ten or more years of
service or to their beneficiaries who are receiving a
monthly benefit from the system, in accordance with
this paragraph; provided that the requirement of ten
or more years of service shall not apply in the case
of a person who retires with less than ten years of
service because of a service connected disability; and
provided further that if the retirant or pensioner is
currently receiving a larger bonus than what would be
payable under this paragraph the retirant or pensioner
shall continue to receive the bonus amount received on
June 30, 1990, until the retirant's or pensioner's
bonus calculated under this paragraph exceeds the June
30, 1990, bonus amount at which time the difference
between the June 30, 1990, bonus and the bonus
calculated under this paragraph would be payable.

The bonus amounts payable under this paragraph shall be based on years of retirement and shall be a cumulative amount to include all previous bonuses and shall not exceed:

14		years by July 1 in the year in which the bonus is
15		effective;
16	(D)	\$6.00 for each year of the retirant's or
17		pensioner's credited service if the retirant or
18		pensioner has been retired a minimum of twenty
19		years by July 1 in the year in which the bonus is
20		effective;
21	(E)	\$8.75 for each year of the retirant's or
22		pensioner's credited service if the retirant or

1	(12)	Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary,
2		in fiscal year 2002-2003, each state and county
3		retiree who is seventy years of age and older with at
4		least twenty years of credited service as of June 30,
5		2002, shall receive a one time, lump sum bonus of
6		\$200. Any lump sum bonus paid pursuant to this
7		paragraph shall not be construed to increase a
8		retirant's basic monthly pension accumulation or any
9		other post retirement benefit provided under this
10		chapter[+]; and
11	(13)	Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary,
12		in fiscal year 2008-2009, each state or county retires
13		who is seventy-five years of age or older with at
14		least twenty years of retirement as of June 30, 2008,
15		shall receive a one-time, lump sum bonus equal to \$1
16		per month per year of service earned by the retiree.
17		Any lump sum bonus paid pursuant to this paragraph
18		shall not be construed to increase a retirant's basic
19		monthly pension accumulation or any other post

21	SECT	ION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
22	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much

- deposit into the employees' retirement systems' operating budget 2
- 3 (BUF 141), to provide retirees who are age seventy-five or older
- and who have at least twenty years of retirement as of June 30, 4
- 2008, a one-time, lump sum pension bonus equal to \$1 per month 5
- per year of service earned by the retiree. 6
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the employees'
- 8 retirement systems for the purposes of this Act.
- SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9
- and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 10
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
